



HIGHLANDS PRESBYTERIAN CAMP PARTICIPANT COVENANT 2008

The following covenant must be read, signed and turned in before your camp or retreat begins. By signing this, you are agreeing to live by the following covenant for your entire stay at Highlands.

In order to create a fun, inclusive and safe environment for everybody, during my stay at Highlands I will:

- Serve and treat others in a Christ-like manner.
- Treat others as I wish to be treated.
- Remember that there is a time for everything (a time for fun, a time for work, a time to be serious, a time to be loud, a time to be quiet, etc.) and will therefore be aware of “what time it is” and act accordingly.
- Recognize that Highlands is a substance free zone (i.e. no alcohol, drugs, etc). If I suspect that someone is in possession of these items at camp, I will immediately notify a staff member.
- Remember that Highlands is a safe place. Therefore, I will not bring any weapons.
- Listen to, and abide by, requests of adults and staff, as they have my best interests in mind, and let them know of my whereabouts at all times.
- Attend all events throughout the duration of the camp or retreat and be responsible for making sure I am at the appropriate place at the appropriate time.
- Take responsibility in helping to keep Highlands clean and in good condition.
- (If I am under 21 years of age) check in my car keys when I arrive and will not drive anywhere – particularly off of camp grounds – during my stay.

I agree to the above covenant and understand that, if I fail to honor it, I will be asked to meet with the Director of Summer Camp and Youth Events or staff of my camp or retreat. In cases where either repeated or gross violations are made, my parents may be called and may have to come pick me up.
